We also have a large selection of engineered flooring with real wood veneers over a stable, manufactured base normally made from plywood or blockboard. The engineered flooring is also available in a great variety of timbers, widths, styles and finishes.

The majority of wooden flooring comes with two finishes, lacquered or oiled. Each has its own advantages and disadvantages. Lacquered floors are far easier to maintain on a day to day basis but are difficult to repair if there is surface damage and are not particularly suitable for high traffic areas. Oiled floors on the other hand, age and wear well and can be re-oiled to bring out the character of the timber.
